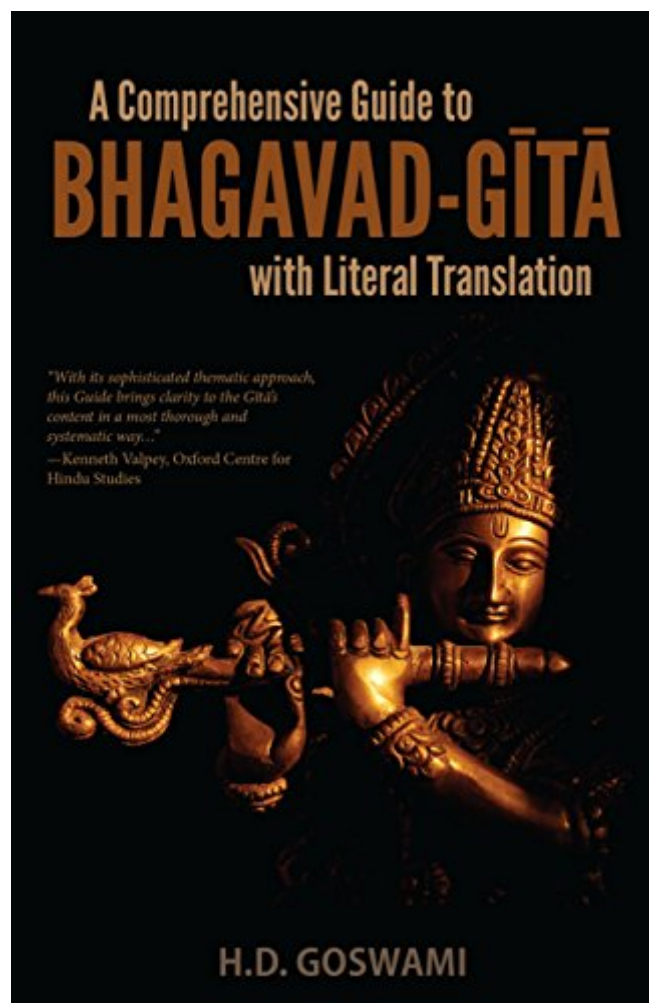

I have taught the Bhagavad-gita, in depth, since the early 80's, and been a student of the gita since the early 70's. This guide book is the best I have read. It's simply superb whether the reader has an academic or spiritual interest, or both. The author has organized the text in such a way, with reference to the verses, that the flow and purpose of the gita are crystal clear. It's also a joyful

reading experience. It's not often one finds a "can't put down" book in this genre.

While I have read many translations/commentaries of the Bhagavad-gita over the years, this one is peerless in providing a stunning synthesis of topics/themes that trace their way throughout the verses. These key concepts can be easily missed by those who don't have a mastery of the original language (as the author does). Many of these themes uncovered are not merely abstractions for intellectual reflection, but concrete invitations to hear the core of the BG, the call to faithful and fruitful devotion that offers meaning, freedom and joy.
