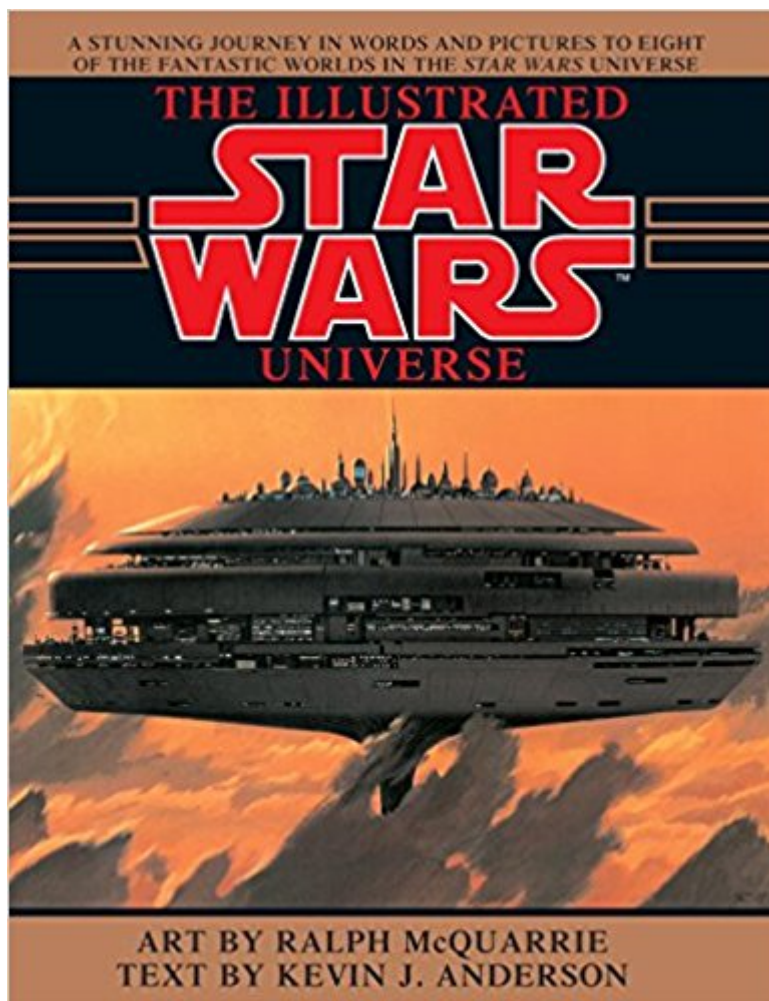

The art by Ralph McQuarrie is brilliant and includes works new for this book as well as some classic original trilogy concept paintings. Surprisingly, the writing keeps pace with the visual elements. Stories of the principal planets from the original trilogy (Tatooine, Hoth, Dagobah, Bespin, Coruscant, and Alderaan) are told from the perspective of explorers, rebels, Imperials, and war protesters and I have been entertained during multiple readings of this book.

The Illustrated Star Wars book seems to be dominated by "Empire" and "Return" art. There are just not enough paintings and designs from Star Wars, Episode IV, proper. I like the other movies' production art but it's obvious that once Star Wars was a hit Lucas could afford much higher quality production paintings. By the eighties gone were the clunky 70s-inspired paintings. But more glossy, clean, highly detailed production art can be a bit one-note. I was hoping for more of that late-seventies look that made the first Star Wars movie, and its design, so unique.

My parents were silly and sold my childhood books. Now I got my childhood back. This book really is a gem, and the seller delivered exactly as promised!
