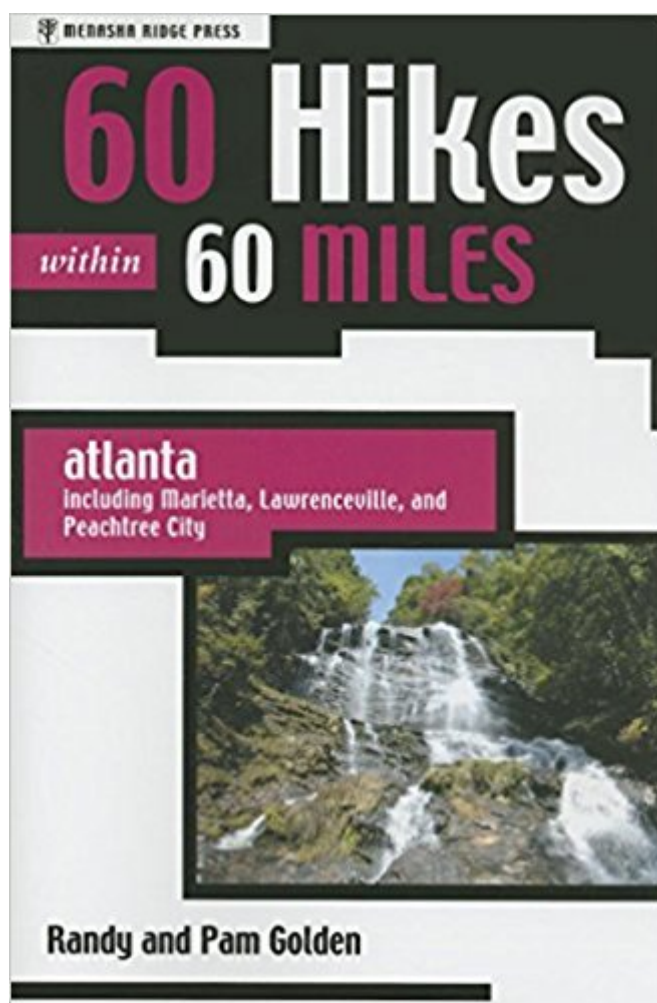

Upon initial review of this book, the inside cover has a handy map of Atlanta and the surrounding areas. This map has the approximate locations of hikes, so that one may choose a hike from a specific area. Unfortunately, the few points on the map that I know and have hiked are grossly wrong. Some points are off by 30 or more miles. Here are examples of hikes that are located in the wrong place: Starr's Mill (Shown at Sweetwater Nongame) Sweetwater Nongame (Shown at Pine Mountain) Pine Mountain (Shown at Spirewell Bluff) Spirewell Bluff (Shown at Starr's Mill) With this quick glance and the glaring errors noted, I have immediately returned the book, not wanting to find out what further errors are waiting to be found.
