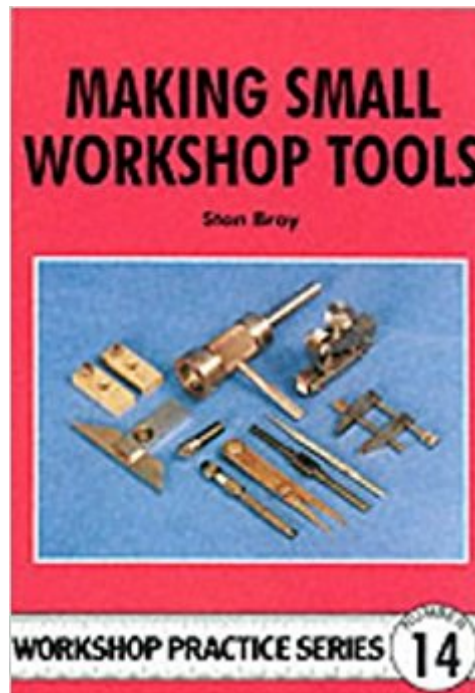

Stan Bray is a model engineer and author of wide experience including editorship of the magazine Model Engineers' Workshop and has written many books covering subjects from clock making to machine shop techniques.

This is not one of the gems of the series. The tools described are indeed small and simple. The writing style is not especially clear. Try "Simple Workshop Devices" by Tubal Cain or "Model Engineer's Workshop Projects" by Harold Hall for something with a little more meat.

I like this book. Like my previous review, I bought the book, not simply because I wanted to build the tools, but as a source of exercises, to periodically build the tools and maintain my skill set. That is one of the major points of the book, not just to build the tools, but to build them to a very high degree of precision, fit & finish.
