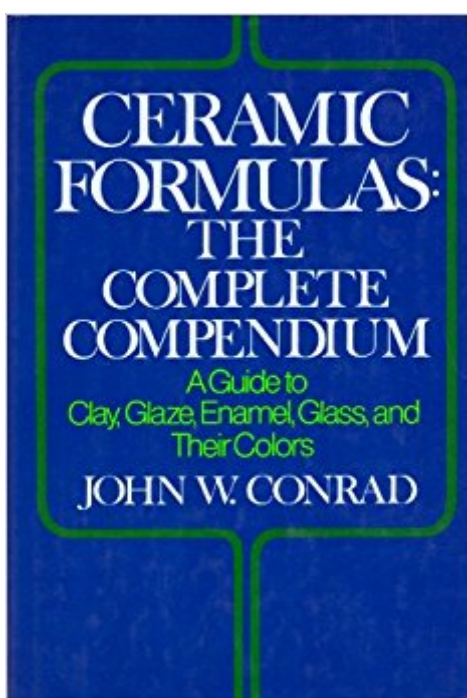

There are several formulas in this book that I was able to use for my Intermediate college level ceramics course. It is an older book, so some of the ingredients were no longer available, however as with most updated recipes there are other ingredients that can be used in substitution. The number of useful formulas outweighed the outdate ones. This is a very useful and helpful book for those that want to mix their own glazes, and know how to do so correctly.

A great addition to any ceramic artists collection of clay and glaze reference books. If you mix your own glazes, this is a great book.

I was very disappointed with this primarily recipe book, because these recipes contain lead, which has been removed from most current ceramic glaze recipes.

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
