

First of all, let me begin by saying what I enjoyed about this book. #1 - I loved the cover art, it's very intense and well designed. #2 - The synopsis for this book is very well written and makes you want to read the book immediately. #3 - The story is actually based around a cool modern idea for a thriller / mystery. Unfortunately, there were a few things that make this book only a three star book for me. While the book sounds amazing, the story itself was lacking in many areas and was bland. I was left wanting for more details and more in-depth characters. I didn't connect to a single character, not even the main ones, and that's not a good sign. Another thing that I have noticed more and more in YA fiction is the number of grammatical and spelling errors that are very plain to see. I wonder how you could read this book and not find yourself doing a double take due to some very obvious spelling and sentence issues. It needs another edit...like just a quick one would take care of some of the things that kept this from being a flawless read. Overall, it wasn't horrible, but it didn't deliver on the brilliant storyline that was promised in the book description. It felt rushed at the

end and I had higher hopes for the book than what I read.

I really wanted to like this book. I thought the concept was great, and even though the multiple third person POVs was confusing, I decided not to worry about keeping track of every character (which I paid for later). However, I found myself skimming a lot, as we spent so much time in the main character's mind (well, all of their minds, really). Move along, please. Also the "lessons learned" about social media just didn't sound like a conclusion coming from a teenager. It was preachy. Finally, I didn't buy a major plot point at the end (won't spoil it), but I had to shake my head at how unrealistic it was. So although intriguing and well-written, it was not a favorite for me.

Great story for reluctant readers. No sex or profanity, just great examples of cause and affect. A view of social media that may make readers uncomfortable, but needs to be considered. I finished it in one sitting just to see how it was going to end. I was not disappointed either. An interesting cautionary tale about social media of today.
