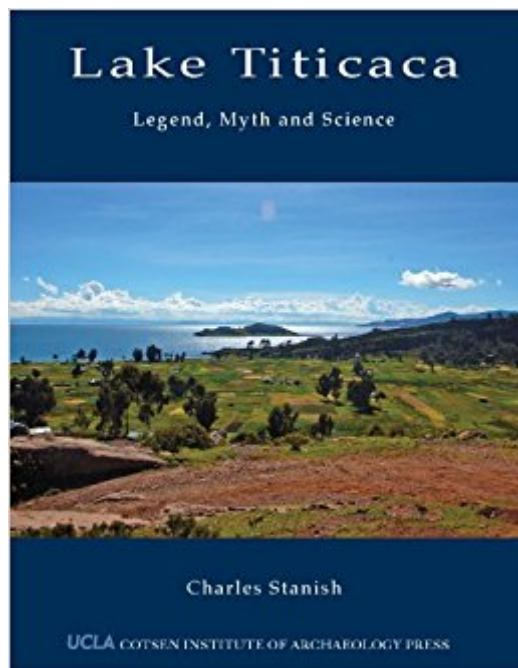




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Lake Titicaca: Legend, Myth And Science (World Heritage And Monuments)
