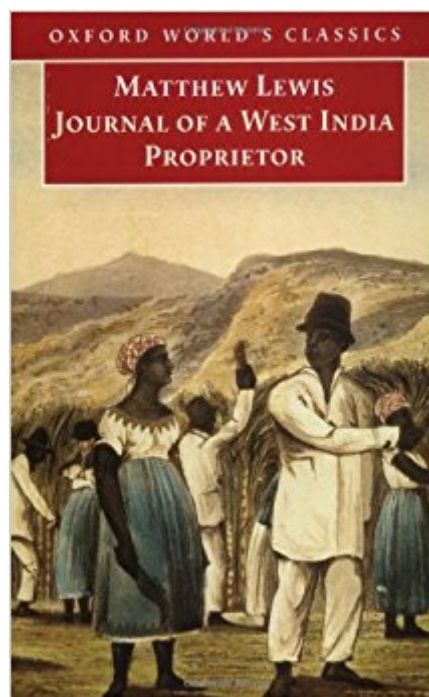




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Journal Of A West India Proprietor: Kept During A Residence In The Island Of Jamaica (Oxford World's Classics)

Matthew Lewis is best remembered as the author of the sensational Gothic novel *The Monk*. He was also a slave-owner, inheriting two large plantations and making two visits to Jamaica to investigate the living and working conditions of his slaves.
