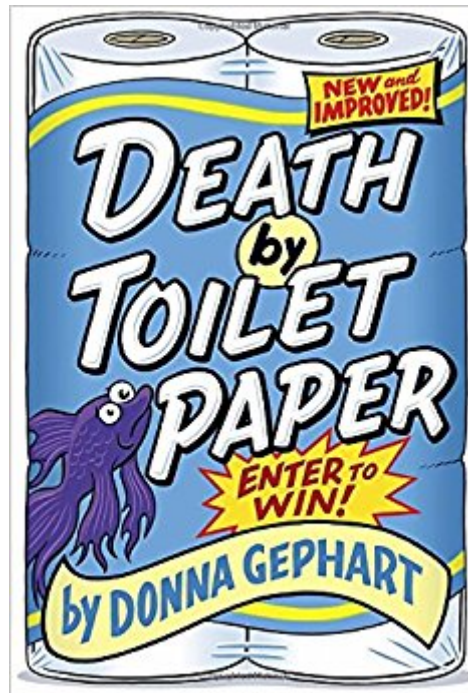




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Death By Toilet Paper

Medical expenses have cleaned out the family's savings, and her job as a waitress doesn't bring in enough money to cover their rent. Ben's mom has one more expensive test to take to earn her CPA license and start a new job, but in the

meantime, they are facing eviction. Ben, an experienced sweepstakes enthusiast, discovers a contest sponsored by the Royal-T toilet paper company with a \$10,000 grand prize, and he knows this could be the solution to his family's problems. Compounding those troubles are a bully at school and Ben's grandfather, Zeyde Jake, who has Alzheimer's and comes to live with Ben and his mom. Ben is a determined, likable character whom readers will doggedly root for, and Gephart infuses his story with humor and heart as she tenderly explores issues of grief, loss, family, and friendship. What's more, the amusing ending—featuring a zombie bride in a toilet paper wedding dress—will leave everyone satisfied. Donna Gephart is one of our most accomplished comic writers for kids -- she really knows how to

tickle the middle-grade funny bone. Although I love all her books, I think I love this one most. The story unrolls with a gross-gory scene (spoiler: it involves salsa) and then we're off on a whirling toilet bowl of a ride with Benjamin Epstein, who has big plans to save the family from eviction and the perils of scratchy bathroom tissue. Gephart isn't just funny, she writes with tons of heart -- we really feel for Benjamin, suffer with him in his losses and celebrate his triumphs when he flushes away his troubles at last. The story is also packed with interesting bathroom-related trivia (remember Mr. Whipple? Know the first recorded use of toilet paper?). Highly recommended for both boys and girls.
