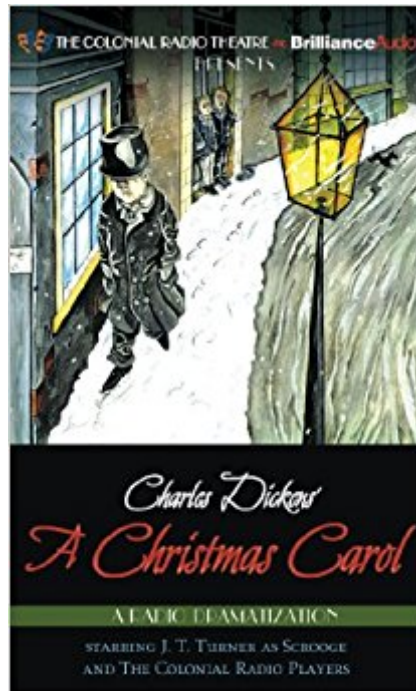




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Charles Dickens' A Christmas Carol: A Radio Dramatization

British novelist Charles Dickens was born on February 7, 1812, in Portsmouth, England. Over the course of his writing career, he wrote the beloved classic novels – Oliver Twist, A Christmas Carol, Nicholas Nickleby, David Copperfield, A Tale of Two Cities and Great Expectations. On June 9, 1870, Dickens died of a stroke in Kent, England, leaving his final novel, The Mystery of Edwin Drood, unfinished. Jerry Robbins, co-founder of the Colonial Radio Theatre on the Air has written and produced over 350 radio plays, including Ticonderoga, Captain Blood, The Legend of Sleepy Hollow, Gettysburg, Treasure Island, Yankee Clipper, Powder River, and Little Big Horn. In 2006 he started a collaboration with legendary author Ray Bradbury, producing Dandelion Wine, followed by Something Wicked This Way Comes, and wrote the script for, and produced The Halloween Tree; all award winning productions that garnered high praise from the master himself. He is currently working on a fourth collaboration with Mr. Bradbury, a radio dramatization of The Martian Chronicles.

This radio play version remains my favorite and we will be listening to it again on Christmas Eve. I have heard all the others, and this one just seems to have more heart and life to it, and doesn't give the feeling of actors standing in a warm studio in front of microphones. It is faithful to the book, and the Scrooge and Marley scene is absolutely frightening. The cast is perfect, and the music is outstanding, which one expects with Colonial Radio Theatre.

This is by far the best version of Charles Dickens Christmas Carol I have heard. This is very faithful to the narrative of the book. The voice actors, narrator, and music are all outstanding. If you like the Christmas Carol story, you will very much enjoy this Colonial Radio dramatization.
